
Results Frameworks

- Maps linkages between program activities and their intended outcomes as they relate to the overall goal
- Assists in designing effective programs and measuring results


Results Frameworks

- Goal: Is at the top and is the highest level desired outcomes of a set of projects
- Purpose: The key result (outcome) to be achieved by the project and the rational for the project
- Outputs: Tangible, immediate and intended products or consequences of a project
- Inputs: Tasks, processes and resources that the project is expected to undertake or consume in order to produce outputs. Examples: technical assistance, training, commodities or equipment
