

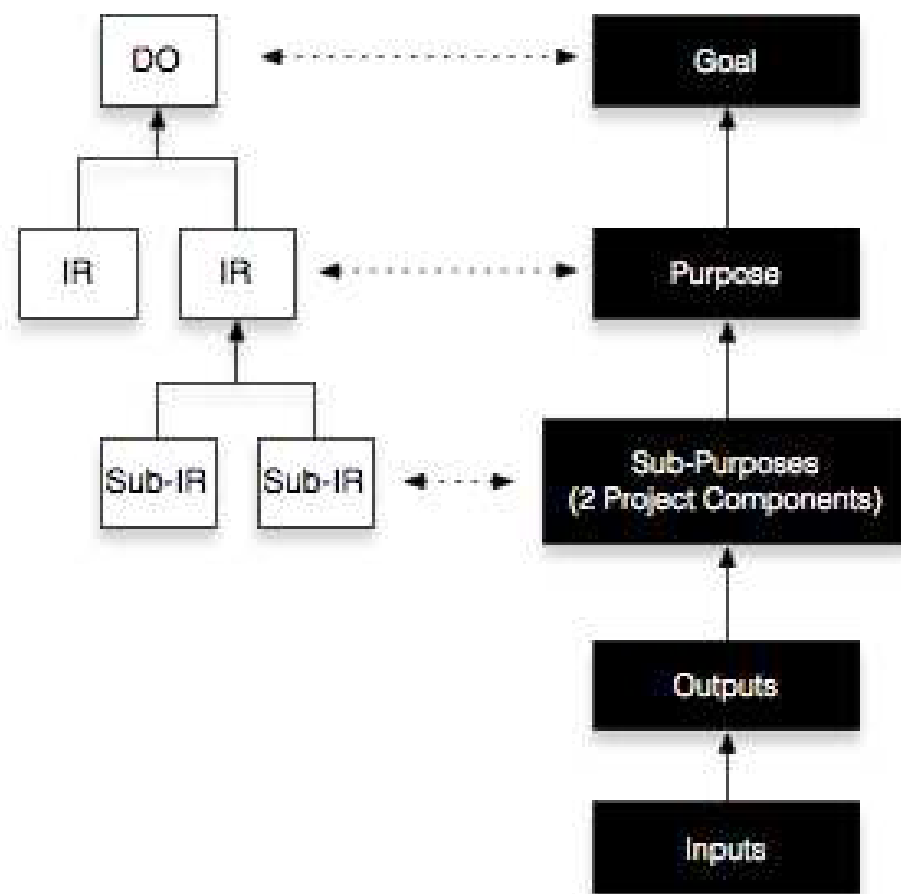
Results Frameworks

Results Frameworks

- Maps linkages between program activities and their intended outcomes as they relate to the overall goal
- Assists in designing effective programs and measuring results

Results Frameworks

- **Goal:** Is at the top and is the highest level desired outcomes of a set of projects
- **Purpose:** The key result (outcome) to be achieved by the project and the rationale for the project
- **Outputs:** Tangible, immediate and intended products or consequences of a project
- **Inputs:** Tasks, processes and resources that the project is expected to undertake or consume in order to produce outputs. Examples: technical assistance, training, commodities or equipment



Feed the Future Goal: Sustainably Reduce Global Poverty and Hunger

Indicators: *Prevalence of poverty & Prevalence of underweight children*

First Level Objective:
Inclusive agriculture sector growth

Indicators: -Agriculture sector GDP
 - Women's and men's incomes in rural households

First Level Objective:
Improved nutritional status esp. of women & children

Indicators: -Prevalence of stunted children
 -Prevalence of wasted children
 -Prevalence of underweight women

Second-Level Objectives

Improved agriculture productivity

-Gross margins per unit of land or animal of selected product

Improved markets

-Percent change in value of intra-regional exports of targeted commodities
 - Value of incremental sales (farm-/firm level)

Increased private investment in agriculture and nutrition-related activities

-Value of new private investment in agriculture sector or value chain

Increased agricultural value chain on- and off-farm jobs

-Jobs created by investment in agricultural value chains

Increased resilience of vulnerable communities and households

-Household Hunger Scale

Improved access to diverse and quality foods

-Dietary diversity for women and children

Improved nutrition-related behaviors

-Exclusive breastfeeding under six months

Improved use of maternal and child health and nutrition services

-Prevalence of maternal anemia
